

# THE TOP 10 THINGS TO DO AT FAKAHATCHEE STRAND PRESERVE STATE PARK

IN ORDER TO SERVE YOU BETTER, WE HAVE COMPILED A LIST OF  
THE MOST POPULAR ACTIVITIES HERE IN THE PARK.

1. TAKE A DRIVE DOWN JANES SCENIC DRIVE TO SEE AN ARRAY OF WILDLIFE SUCH AS DEER, OTTERS, AND THE RED-SHOULDERED HAWK.
2. YOU MIGHT SEE ONE OF OUR ENDANGERED ANIMALS SUCH AS THE FLORIDA PANTHER, EVERGLADES MINK, AND THE FLORIDA BLACK BEAR.
3. HIKE DOWN ONE OF OUR MANY SCENIC TRAMS.
4. WHILE HIKING TRY TO IDENTIFY ONE OF OUR OVER 70 RARE AND/OR ENDANGERED PLANTS.
5. WALK DOWN OUR BOARDWALK THAT TAKES YOU INTO AN OLD GROWTH CYPRESS STAND.
6. WHILE WALKING DOWN THE BOARDWALK LOOK FOR ALLIGATORS AND THE MANY FERNS AND BROMELIADS GROWING ON THE TREES.
7. COME AND SEE THE LARGEST STAND OF ROYAL PALM TREES IN THE UNITED STATES! JUST OFF JANES SCENIC DRIVE ON THE GATE 12 TRAIL (6.5 MILES FROM THE RANGER STATION).
8. TAKE A CANOE TRIP DOWN EAST RIVER.
9. SPEND YOUR EXTRA TIME VOLUNTEERING TO HELP THE PRESERVE.
10. GO ON A SATURDAY SWAMP WALK WITH THE FRIENDS OF FAKAHATCHEE (NOVEMBER-APRIL, RESERVATIONS: (239) 695-1023).
